

Important Safety Notice

Children's Full Zip Fleece Hooded Sweatshirts with Drawstrings Recalled for Strangulation Hazard



WASHINGTON, D.C. - In cooperation with the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, we are recalling children's upper outerwear containing drawstrings at the hood or neck because they pose a strangulation hazard to children. Please immediately remove the referenced products from use by children and either cut the drawstrings to remove the potential strangulation hazard or return the clothing to us for a full refund or a replacement product.

Name of Product: Children's Full Zip Hooded Fleece Sweatshirts with Drawstring

Units: 3,240

Distributor: The Bon-Ton Department Stores, Inc., York, PA

Hazard: The garments have a drawstring through the hood, posing a strangulation hazard to children. In February 1996, CPSC issued [guidelines](#) to help prevent children from strangling or getting entangled on the neck and waist by drawstrings in upper garments, such as jackets and sweatshirts.

Description: Boys' "Burnside" brand, hooded zip-up jackets, boys' sizes small, medium, large and X-large in various colors, RN # 39209 is on the tag
