### **GIRLS' JACKETS WITH DRAWSTRINGS RECALLED BY BON-TON STORES DUE TO STRANGULATION HAZARD**

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, in cooperation with the firm named below, today announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer product. Consumers should stop using recalled products immediately unless otherwise instructed.

**Name of Product:** Girl's Cargo Pocket Jackets

**Units:** About 290

**Retailer:** The Bon-Ton Department Stores, Inc. of York, PA

**Hazard:** The drawstrings on the neck and waist of the jacket can pose a strangulation or entrapment hazard to children.

**Incident/Injuries:** None reported.

**Description:** This recall involves Byer California ( d/b/a Amy Byer or Philly of San Francisco) girls' brown cargo jackets sold in sizes small through extra-large. The Style Number 2029G1J is printed on the label inside the jacket.

**Sold at:** Bon-Ton; Bergner's, Boston Store, Elder-Beerman, Herberger's, Younkers and Carson Pirie Scott Stores nationwide between February, 2009 and April, 2010.

**Manufactured in:** China

**Remedy:** Consumers should remove the drawstring immediately or return the jacket to the store where purchased for a full refund.
